MENS 6' & UNDER BASKETBALL RULES

1. 6' & Under League players **MUST be NO more than 6'1" with shoes.** Teams will be measured through the third week of play.
2. Rosters are due at the first game with all information complete & signed. There will be a grace period of one week to hand in the roster. If rosters are not handed in before the **first week** of play, **teams will forfeit their games until the rosters are handed in.** If the roster is not handed in by the **second week** of play, **the team captain will be notified of termination of league play without a refund.** After that time, no changes will be made to the roster. At tournament time there will be no additions or changes. Legal tournament players **must have played in two league games.**
3. Games are two 18-minute halves, with a running clock until the last 30 seconds of first half and last 2 minutes of the game. This includes shooting foul shots. The clock will stop for time-outs. Half time will be 5 minutes, to be determined by the supervisor. Each team is allowed four time-outs per game. (Two per half)
4. **Overtime** is three minutes. Stop clock in the last minute with one time-out per team.
5. **Game time is game time.** There will be no grace period for any game. Each team must have four players to start and finish the game. If a team has four players and a player fouls out, is ejected, gets injured, or otherwise cannot finish the game, the team will forfeit the game.
6. All teams must have uniforms. Uniforms need to be the same color with a 4"-6" contrasting number on the back. If a player does not have a uniform, they cannot play in the game.
7. Players must be **16 years** or older. Any player under 18 will need to have a parent or guardian fill out and sign a waiver. Waivers can be received at the Recreation Office Monday – Friday from 8am – 5:30pm.
8. **Protests:** Notification of intent to protest **MUST** be made **BEFORE** play resumes. The manager shall immediately notify the head official and the scorekeeper that the game is being continued under protest. Protests then must be filed in writing at the recreation office by 5:00pm the following work day with a \$50.00 protest fee. If the protest is upheld, the check is returned. Protest forms are available from the scorekeeper.
9. **CONDUCT:** As a manager or team representative, you are responsible for your team. The officials, site supervisors, and scorekeepers have been encouraged to

be quick to correct any abusive language or actions. My personal philosophy, **there are no warnings**. If your behavior would offend any member of my family or embarrass yours any recreation department personnel, at any time, have the right to ask you to leave the gym and possibly the program.

10. In the unlikely event of an “**ejection**”, the player will leave the facility & not return for **TWO** games. With the first technical, the player is required to sit out for **5 minutes**. If it occurs at the end of a game, they will be required to sit out the remainder plus the beginning of the next scheduled game. Chronic offenders will be suspended for the season at the judgement of the scorekeeper and/or site supervisor.
11. If a team is removed from the league for disciplinary reasons, their registration fees will **NOT** be reimbursed.

If in the event that you, the team manager, withdraw your team from the program on or after the day of the Manager’s meeting, there will be a \$25.00 **Handling Fee**. This fee will be taken out of the refund check.
