Re: FLINT STREET AND GENTILE STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT

To Whom it May Concern:

Beginning on or about June 21, 2010 and lasting until approximately August 20, 2010 construction will take place on a traffic signal at the intersection of Gentile Street and Flint Street. A traffic signal at this intersection will significantly improve the flow, and safety of traffic transiting this area. Construction activities will include the following: construction of a median within the roadway to allow for a separation of traffic and permit the free flow of west bound vehicles when the project is completed; boring under the roadway for the installation of conduit and power to the signal poles; concrete work at various locations within the area. Delays and possible road closure may be encountered periodically throughout the construction period. We ask for your cooperation and understanding and apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause you.
