WHY CERT?

Every year there are communities that fall victim to some catastrophic event or disaster. A disaster may take the form of an earthquake, a flood, high winds, a blizzard or a so called "man-made" disaster. During catastrophic events, the public's immediate life safety needs will greatly exceed the City's police, fire and emergency medical response capabilities. Individuals and neighborhoods will need to care for themselves until outside help is available. The purpose of CERT training is to provide citizens with the basic skills to handle virtually all their own needs, and then respond to their community's needs in the aftermath of a disaster.

WHO SHOULD TAKE THE COURSE?

Private citizens, businesses and schools who desire the skills and knowledge required to prepare for and respond to a disaster.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost is \$25 per person to cover the costs of medical supplies, personal protective equipment, and other costs.

WHAT IS CERT?

CERT stands for Community Emergency Response Teams and consists of a 24-hour course. Classes are taught by trained volunteers.
